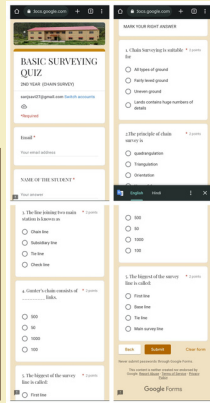

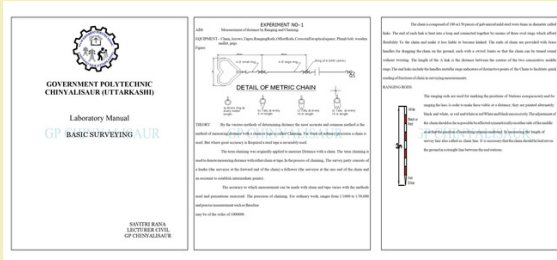

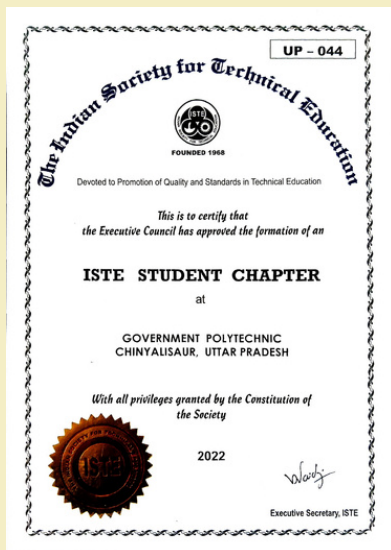
Students collected stones and woods available near the institute campus. They coloured and decorated these materials with enthusiasm.

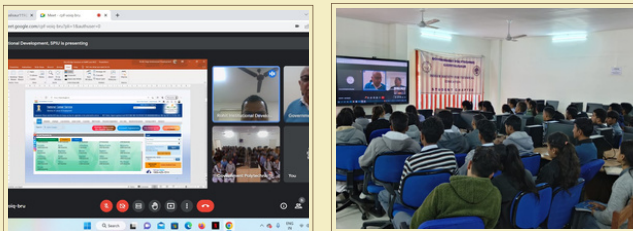

# हिन्दी पृष्ठ

## पहाड़ नहीं, जिंदगी खोखली की है हमने

उत्तराखण्ड के गढ़वाल क्षेत्र के अंतर्गत चमोली जिले में स्थित जोशीमठ शहर पर आज दुनियाभर की निगाहें ठहरी हुई है। भू-धंसाव के चलते इस शहर और इसके आसपास के क्षेत्रों में हालात खराब हैं। पहाड़ दरक रहे हैं, घरों की बुनियाद में पानी रिस रहा है। बेबसी भरे सर्द मौसम में लोगों को अपना घर छोड़कर भागना पड़ा है। एक हजार के लगभग घरों को खतरे की जद में मान कर उन पर लाल निशान लगा दिए गए हैं और उन्हें ढहाने की प्रक्रिया शुरू हो गई है। अपने खून पसीने की कमाई से बने घर को अपनी नजरों के सामने गिरता हुआ देखना, आपाधापी में दूसरी जगह विस्थापित होना, स्थानीय लोगों के लिए बहुत कठिन है। जड़ों से टूटकर जीने का फलसफा क्या होता है, इस हादसे को झेल रहे लोग बेहतर जानते हैं। भवनों को गिराना तो आसान है लेकिन जिन लोगों ने पाई पाई जोड़ कर अपना घर बनाया उनके मन को सैलाना आसान नहीं। स्थानीय लोगों को भी थोड़े से लालच में अपनी जमीन नहीं बेचने से परहेज करना होगा। पहले बड़े-बड़े होटलों और रिसॉर्ट्स के निर्माण की अनुमति, फिर उनका ध्वस्तीकरण। काश! पहले ही मानकों का पालन हुआ होता। पहाड़ों की संवेदनशीलता को समझकर, परखकर वैज्ञानिक तरीके से निर्माण कार्य होते तो आज यह दिन नहीं देखना पड़ता। यह तय है कि किसी भी तरह के सत्ता लाभ या राजनीतिक फायदे को ध्यान में रखकर प्रकृति के हित में सोचकर ही ईमानदार कदम उठाना सबके हित में होगा, क्योंकि जोशीमठ तो एक उदाहरण मात्र है। नैनीताल जिला अनुचित ढंग से बस गया है। माल रोड धसती जा रही है, अस्थाई उपचार से शहर को जीवित रखने वाली बात है। बागेश्वर समेत कई ऐसे स्थान हैं जो दिन-ब-दिन खोखले होते जा रहे हैं। विनाश की अंधी सुरंग विकास का प्रतीक कभी नहीं हो सकती। हमें छांव देने वाले पेड़, हवा और पहाड़ आज हमारी संवेदनाओं की छांव में बैठे हैं। हर कोई इनके दरकने पर अपनी सहानुभूति प्रकट कर रहा है, लेकिन वर्षों से पहाड़ों का नुकसान तो हम ही करते आए हैं। जोशीमठ ही नहीं समूचा हिमालय चीख चीख कर कह रहा है मुझे बचा लो।
